Guidelines for Authors

Authors of accepted abstracts may submit their full paper for the International Conference as per the Guidelines as mentioned below. The papers which are not following these guidelines may not be considered for peer review and publication.

Preparation of Abstract

- The Abstract should be in doc / docx; Title should be in Times New Roman 14 pt & Bold; Affiliation should be in 10 pt; Abstract should be in 12 pt Bold; Text of Abstract should be in 12 pt.
- Only those abstracts which follow the mentioned format will be considered for evaluation by the Scientific Committee of the Conference. The Abstract should be submitted in: on or before 28th February 2020.

Preparation of Power point Presentation

• 8 min presentation followed by 2 min discussion

Preparation of Poster

- On evaluation, the Abstracts may be selected either for Oral or Poster presentation.
- Poster size should be 1 m x 1 m

The Organizers will confer Best Oral and Best Poster Awards based on the quality of presentations as would be adjudicated by the Panel of Experts.

Preparation of Full Text of Paper

Papers should be camera-ready in MS-Word format, not exceeding 10 pages in length and should not carry more than 5 illustrations /photographs. The language of the Publication is English. The mode of presentation should be in third person. The Template for preparation of article is attached for ready reference of the authors. SI units should be used wherever possible. Other units, if used, should be given only in parentheses preceded by SI units. Mathematical symbols should be typed and care should be taken to differentiate between similar characters (e.g. 1 and I), upper and lower case letters and superscripts and subscripts. Lengthy mathematical proofs and derivations and extensive test data are discouraged. If absolutely essential, they should be given as an appendix. The template of Paper can be downloaded from the paper submission guidelines from the conference website.

Copyright

The papers are considered for possible publication on the understanding that these have not been submitted to any other publisher. The copyright of papers accepted for publication lies with the conference organizer and reproduction of the papers or any part thereof is not allowed without the permission of the Institution. Contributors are required to sign a declaration to this effect while submitting their papers. The Declaration form of journal can be downloaded from the conference website.

About Raipur City:

Raipur is the capital and largest city of the state of Chhattisgarh. Raipur is an emerging global hub and has witnessed exponential growth over the past years. It contains a diverse population of about a million and spans across an area of 180 sq km. It holds 7th position in the Ease of Living Index 2018 by Union Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs. The city is located near the centre of a large plain, wherein hundreds of varieties of rice are grown, by virtue of which Chhattisgarh is the 'Rice bowl of India'. It has The Mahanadi river on its east, Maikal Hills on the north-west, Deccan plateau on the south and on the north, land rises and merges with the Chota Nagpur Plateau. Archaeological evidence suggest the existence of Raipur since the ninth century, whereas literary evidence define the history of Raipur since the Raipur being geographically located at the centre of Chhattisgarh was chosen to be its capital on 1st November 2000. It also holds a various international brands and prominent global automobile Raipur also occurs to be the educational hub of Chattisgarh due to the presence of innumerable educational institutions of importance. It is home to premier institutes like Indian Institute of Technology, Bhilai (IIT Bhilai), National Institute of Technology (NIT), All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Hidayatullah National Law University, International Institute of Information Technology (IIIT) and National Institute of Malaria Research.
